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Introduction

This report is based on findings from a scientific national survey conducted by the <u>Yale Program on</u> <u>Climate Change Communication (climatecommunication.yale.edu)</u> and the <u>George Mason University</u> <u>Center for Climate Change Communication (climatechangecommunication.org)</u> and fielded by <u>Climate</u> <u>Nexus Polling (climatenexus.org/polls/climate-change-polling</u>). Interview dates: April 3 – 7, 2020. Interviews: 3,933 adults (18+), 3,188 of whom are registered to vote. Average margin of error: +/- 2 percentage points at the 95% confidence level. A special thank you to Parrish Bergquist, PhD, Xinran Wang, and Andry Rajaoberison for automating the data tables. The research was funded by the Catalyst Fund at the Yale School of Forestry and Environmental Studies.

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Reading notes

- References to Republicans, Democrats, and Independents include only registered voters. References to Republicans and Democrats include registered voters who initially identified as either a Republican or Democrat, as well as those who did not initially identify as a Republican or Democrat but who said they "are closer to" one of those parties in a follow-up question (i.e., "leaners"). The category "Independents" does not include any of these "leaners."
- Data tables presenting item responses broken out by age, race, gender, area of residence (urban/suburban/rural), political partisanship, and education are available in Appendix I (pp. 15-120). Data tables broken out by health status are also available in Appendix I (pp. 121-138). For those, respondents indicated if a doctor has ever diagnosed them or someone in their household with the following health conditions: hypertension (high blood pressure), coronary heart disease, diabetes, and/or respiratory illness including asthma. Respondents who selected at least one of these health conditions were coded as having "at least one health issue" and those who did not select any were coded as having "none."
- In the data tables, bases specified are unweighted, but percentages are weighted.
- For tabulation purposes, percentage points are rounded to the nearest whole number. As a result, percentages in a given chart may total slightly higher or lower than 100%. Summed response categories (e.g., "strongly agree" + "somewhat agree") are rounded after sums are calculated (e.g., 25.3% + 25.3% = 50.6%, which, after rounding, would be reported as 25% + 25% = 51%).

 - Liberal Democrats: 26%
 - Moderate/Conservative Democrats: 21%

Executive Summary

Drawing on a scientific national survey (N = 3,933; including 3,188 registered voters), this report describes how the American public is responding to the spread of COVID-19 in the U.S.

Most Americans Say the U.S. Coronavirus Epidemic Has Disrupted their Daily Life

- About seven in ten Americans say their daily life has been disrupted by the spread of the coronavirus either "a lot" (38%) or "some" (34%).
- About four in ten say they or a household member has had trouble sleeping (42%).
- Nearly one in five Americans say they or a household member has filed for unemployment (18%), lost a job (17%), or been unable to get adequate medical care (17%).
- Three in ten or more say they or a household member has lost money in retirement accounts or investments (38%), had work hours reduced (34%), lost income from a job or business (32%), or been unable to get groceries (30%).
- Hispanics/Latinos as well as liberal/moderate Republicans are more likely than other Americans to say they or a member of their household has experienced economic consequences, such as job loss, income loss from a job or business, or reduced work hours.

Americans Are Most Worried about the Impacts of Coronavirus on the Healthcare System and Economy; A Majority Say Worry about the Coronavirus Has Harmed their Mental Health

- Eight in ten or more Americans are worried about the healthcare system being overwhelmed by coronavirus patients (85%), the world experiencing a global economic depression (84%), businesses failing in their local community (82%), and unemployment increasing in their state (80%).
- Hispanics/Latinos are more likely than other Americans to say they are "very worried" about being unable to access medical care and experiencing several economic consequences, such as losing their job, work-related income, or their home. Also, liberal/moderate Republicans are more likely than other Americans to say they are "very" or "somewhat worried" about experiencing several economic consequences.
- A majority of Americans say worry about the coronavirus has harmed their mental health either "a lot" (11%), "some" (18%), or "a little" (25%). Older Americans (aged 60+) and conservative Republicans are more likely than other Americans to say "not at all" when asked if worry about the coronavirus has harmed their mental health. Liberal/moderate Republicans, on the other hand, are more likely than other Americans to say it has harmed their mental health "a lot."

Americans Are Experiencing Many Emotions in Response to the Coronavirus, Especially Compassion and Hope

- Majorities of Americans feel compassionate (64% "very" or "moderately") or hopeful (54%) when they think about the coronavirus.
- Four in ten or more feel anxious (46%), afraid (43%), helpless (42%), or overwhelmed (40%). Fewer Americans feel panicked (28%) or confused (28%).
- Younger Americans (18-29) are less likely than other Americans to say they feel compassionate and are more likely to say they feel bored.





Most Americans Perceive the Coronavirus as a Threat to Vulnerable Populations and People in the U.S.; Fewer Think it will Harm Them Personally

- About three in four Americans think the coronavirus will do "a great deal" of harm to the health of adults aged 65 or older (77%) and to people with chronic health conditions (77%).
- About six in ten think the coronavirus will harm the health of people in the U.S. "a great deal" (62%). Fewer Americans think it will do "a great deal" of harm to the health of people in their local community (32%), children (23%), their family (26%), and themselves personally (25%).
- Democrats, particularly liberal Democrats, are more likely than other Americans to say that the coronavirus will do "a great deal" of harm to the health of vulnerable populations (adults aged 65+ or people with chronic health conditions), people in the U.S., and people in their community.
- As of April 7, most Americans estimated the coronavirus epidemic in the U.S. would end in either 2-3 months (35%) or 4-6 months (29%). Republicans, particularly conservative Republicans, were the most likely to think the coronavirus epidemic in the U.S. would end soon.





1. Life Disruptions from COVID-19

1.1. Most Americans say the coronavirus epidemic has disrupted their daily life.

About seven in ten Americans say their daily life has been disrupted by the spread of the coronavirus either "a lot" (38%) or "some" (34%). Fewer Americans say their daily life has been disrupted "a little" (21%) or "not at all" (5%).

Most Americans Say the Coronavirus Epidemic Has Disrupted Their Daily Life







1.2. How the coronavirus has disrupted daily life.

More than half of Americans say they or a member of their household has been unable to get disinfectant products (57%) or visit family members who are at higher risk of infection (53%). About four in ten say they or a household member has had trouble sleeping (42%). Three in ten or more say they or a household member has lost money in retirement accounts or investments (38%), had work hours reduced (34%), lost income from a job or business (32%), or been unable to get groceries (30%).

Nearly one in five Americans say they or a household member has filed for unemployment (18%), lost a job (17%), or been unable to get adequate medical care (17%). About one in eight say they or a household member has been unable to get prescription medicine (12%).



How the Coronavirus Has Disrupted Daily Life

Hispanics/Latinos – as well as liberal/moderate Republicans – are more likely than other Americans to say they or a member of their household has experienced economic consequences, such as job loss, income loss from a job or business, or reduced work hours (see Appendix I: Data Tables, pp. 99-120).





2. Emotional Responses to COVID-19

2.1. Americans are worried about a range of potential consequences of the spread of the coronavirus.

Large majorities of Americans are worried about the healthcare system and the economy as a result of the spread of COVID-19. Eight in ten or more are worried about the healthcare system being overwhelmed by coronavirus patients (85%), the world experiencing a global economic depression (84%), businesses failing in their local community (82%), and unemployment increasing in their state (80%).

Americans Are Worried About a Range of Potential Consequences of the Spread of the Coronavirus



Majorities of Americans are also worried that they or someone in their family will get sick from the coronavirus (78%), and about food shortages happening where they live (68%), being unable to access medical care (61%), crime increasing where they live (57%), and schools closing (57%). About half of Americans are worried about being unable to pay monthly bills, such as rent and credit cards (52%), their savings losing value (52%), and martial law being declared where they live (52%).

Four in ten or more Americans are worried about being unable to afford groceries (47%), losing work-related income (46%), and the November 2020 election being cancelled (44%). Fewer Americans are worried about property values declining where they live (38%), losing their job (36%), and losing their home (30%).





Hispanics/Latinos are more likely than other Americans to say they are "very worried" about being unable to access medical care and experiencing several economic consequences, such as losing their job, work-related income, or their home (see Appendix I: Data Tables, pp. 61-96). Also, liberal/moderate Republicans are more likely than other Americans to say they are "very" or "somewhat worried" about experiencing economic consequences, including losing their job, work income, or their home, as well as declines in their investments or property values where they live (see Appendix I: Data Tables, pp. 61-96).





2.2. A majority of Americans say worry about the coronavirus has harmed their mental health.

A majority of Americans say worry about the coronavirus has harmed their mental health either "a lot" (11%), "some" (18%), or "a little" (25%). About four in ten (41%) say "not at all."

A Majority of Americans Say Worry About The Coronavirus Has Harmed Their Mental Health



Older Americans (aged 60+) and conservative Republicans are more likely than other Americans to say "not at all" when asked if worry about the coronavirus has harmed their mental health (see Appendix I: Data Tables, pp. 59-60). Liberal/moderate Republicans, on the other hand, are more likely than other Americans to say it has harmed their mental health "a lot" (see Appendix I: Data Tables, p. 60).





2.3. Majorities of Americans feel compassionate and hopeful when they think about the coronavirus.

Although many Americans are worried about the spread of the coronavirus and its impacts, majorities of Americans also feel compassionate (64% "very" or "moderately") or hopeful (54%) when they think about the coronavirus. Four in ten or more also feel anxious (46%), afraid (43%), helpless (42%), or overwhelmed (40%). Three in ten or more feel bored (39%), angry (38%), disgusted (37%), depressed (30%), or lonely (30%). Fewer Americans feel panicked (28%) or confused (28%).

Majorities of Americans Feel Compassionate and Hopeful When They Think About the Coronavirus



Younger Americans (18-29) are less likely than other Americans to say they feel compassionate when think about the coronavirus and are more likely to say they feel bored (see Appendix I: Data Tables, pp. 55 & 57). Older Americans (aged 60+) are more likely to say "not at all" when asked if they feel depressed, panicked, confused, or bored (see Appendix I: Data Tables, pp. 33-58).





3. COVID-19 Risk Perceptions

3.1. Most Americans perceive the coronavirus to be a threat to vulnerable populations and people in the U.S.

Americans perceive that older adults (65+) and people with chronic health conditions are most likely to be harmed by the coronavirus. About three in four Americans think the coronavirus will do "a great deal" of harm to the health of adults aged 65 or older (77%) and to people with chronic health conditions (77%). About six in ten think the coronavirus will harm the health of people in the U.S. "a great deal" (62%). Fewer Americans think it will do "a great deal" of harm to the health of people in their local community (32%), children (23%), their family (26%), and themselves personally (25%).

Most Americans Perceive the Coronavirus To Be A Threat To Vulnerable Populations and People in the U.S.



Democrats, particularly liberal Democrats, are more likely than other Americans to say that the coronavirus will do "a great deal" of harm to the health of vulnerable populations (adults aged 65+ or people with chronic health conditions), people in the U.S., and people in their community (see Appendix I: Data Tables, pp. 15-28).





3.2. A majority of Americans think the coronavirus is harming people in their local community right now.

As of April 7, more than half of Americans (55%) thought the coronavirus was currently harming people in their local community, and about one in four (23%) thought it would harm people within 2-3 weeks. Few Americans (7%) thought it would never harm people in their local community.

3.3. Most Americans estimate the U.S. coronavirus epidemic will end in two to six months.

As of April 7, most Americans estimated the coronavirus epidemic in the U.S. would end in either 2-3 months (35%) or 4-6 months (29%). More than one in four thought it would end in 7 to 12 months (14%), in more than a year (10%), or never (3%). Only about one in ten (9%) thought it would end in about a month.

Most Americans Estimate the U.S. Coronavirus Epidemic Will End in 2-6 Months



Republicans, particularly conservative Republicans, were the most likely to think the coronavirus epidemic in the U.S. would end soon (see Appendix I: Data Tables, p. 32).

Appendix II: Survey Method

The data in this report are based on a scientific online poll of 3,933 American adults, aged 18 and older, conducted by the Yale Program on Climate Change Communication (climatecommunication.yale.edu) and the George Mason University Center for Climate Change Communication (climatechangecommunication.org). Data collection was administered by James Wyatt at Climate Nexus Polling (climatenexus.org). The survey was conducted April 3 – 7, 2020. All questionnaires were self-administered by respondents in a web-based environment. The survey took, on average, 19 minutes to complete. The sample was drawn from a scientific online panel of U.S. respondents using stratified sampling methods. Key demographic variables (age, gender, race and Hispanic ethnicity, income, educational attainment, region) were weighted, post survey, to align with U.S. Census Bureau norms. Weights were trimmed not to exceed 3. Weights range from 0.30 to 3.0, with a mean of 0.99, median of 0.78, and standard deviation of 0.59. 95% of the weights fall between 0.39 and 2.97.

The survey instrument was designed by Anthony Leiserowitz, Matthew Ballew, Parrish Bergquist, Matthew Goldberg, Abel Gustafson, Jennifer Marlon, and Seth Rosenthal of Yale University, and Edward Maibach and John Kotcher of George Mason University. The data tables in this report were automated by Parrish Bergquist, Xinran Wang, and Andry Rajaoberison of Yale University.

Sample details and margins of error

All samples are subject to some degree of sampling error – that is, statistical results obtained from a sample can be expected to differ somewhat from results that would be obtained if every member of the target population were interviewed. Average margins of error, at the 95% confidence level, are plus or minus 2 percentage points.

Rounding error

For tabulation purposes, percentage points are rounded to the nearest whole number. As a result, percentages in a given chart may total slightly higher or lower than 100%. Summed response categories (e.g., "strongly agree" + "somewhat agree") are rounded after sums are calculated (e.g., 25.3% + 25.3% = 50.6%, which, after rounding, would be reported as 25% + 25% = 51%).
